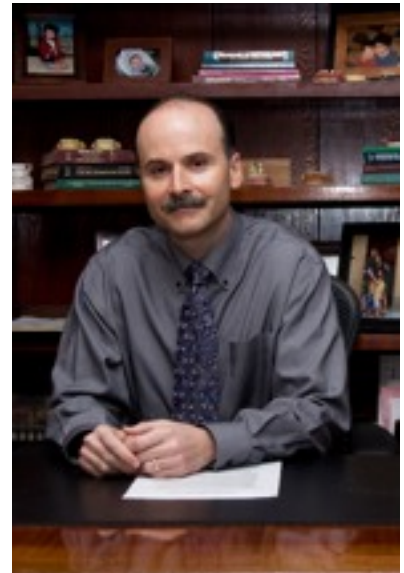

The Treatment of Cervical Tooth Lesions Utilizing Periodontal Plastic Surgery Root Coverage Techniques

The program will focus on the challenges posed by progressive recession, inadequate zones of bound down tissue, root exposure, carious and non-carious lesions. Gingival recession can predispose patients to progressive bone loss, esthetic defects, plaque accumulation, root sensitivity, exposure of restorative margins, and root caries.

Advances in Periodontal Plastic Surgery allow for gingival augmentation and root coverage with minimally invasive techniques that eliminate the need for extensive incisions. Options are available for autografts or donor tissue (acellular dermal matrix)

Dr. Chertok graduated from New York University Dental School. He completed a General Practice Residency at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Manhattan and then a Post-Graduate Residency in Periodontology at UCSF. Dr. Chertok has lectured at UCSF in the Department of Periodontology and was an Assistant Professor in Periodontics at the Dugoni School of Dentistry (UoP). He has been the Director of Continuing Education for the Nova Center and the Berkeley Interdisciplinary Study Network. Dr. Chertok is currently the attending periodontist for the General Practice Residency Program at the VA Northern California Healthcare System at Mare Island and maintains a full time private practice in Berkeley, California with an emphasis on Periodontal Plastic Surgery and Dental Implants.
